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Description of the Competition:

This category allows for high school students to display an Architectural drawing project. A complete project must have at least three (3) architectural drawings, including a floor plan, an elevation view, and a third of the student's choice. Any perspective and rendered drawings are excluded and should not be brought to the competition.

General Rules:

1. Limited to one entry per student.
2. Project must be student work.
3. Students can utilize any tools, programs or machines to produce their drawings.
4. A complete set of hand drawn or computer plotted drawings is required.
5. Student does not need to be present.
6. Limited to three drawings per school

House Plan Requirements:

- Approximately 1500sf (min) -2500sf (max).
Efficient use of living space may be used as a factor in determining the winning entry, in the event of a tie.
- At least 3 bedrooms
- Master bathroom
- Walk in closet
- Laundry area
- 2½ bathrooms
- Kitchen
- Dining area
- Living room
- Cellar Stairs (minimum 36" wide)
- Attached 2 car garage
- Patios, porches, decks, etc. are optional

Judging Criteria:

Judges will review all projects on display. If a project is not complete or displayed, it will not be judged. The judges will award points based on the design, complexity, completeness, difficulty, ANSI standards, etc. All decisions by the judges are final.
